A BILL

For an Act creating Chapter 430 Section 69 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, relating to Gun Control.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.

1 Section I. The purpose of this bill is to ban the sale, manufacture, and possession of multi-
2 burst trigger activators in all places in the State of Illinois.

3 Section II. Anyone caught selling or owning a multi-burst trigger activator could face up to
4 10 years in prison and a fine of \$20,000 for each violation.

5 Section III. The Illinois Department of Justice will oversee the implications of banning the
6 multi-burst trigger activators. Anyone in possession, including stores, will be required to
7 destroy or turn in their multi-burst trigger activator within 90 days of this bill becoming
8 law.

9 Section IV. There will be no need for funding.

10 Section V. This bill will go into effect January 1, 2022 upon signature of the Youth
11 Governor of Illinois.
