A BILL

For an Act creating Chapter 730 Section 145 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, relating to Drug rehabilitation in state prisons.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.

1 Section I. This act shall be known as the Illinois Prison Drug and Substance Abuse  
2 Rehabilitation Program.

3 Section II. All state correctional facilities must have a drug and substance abuse  
4 rehabilitation program. Within this program, they are required to have no more than a 10:1  
5 adult inmate to the specialist ratio for every counseling session.

6 Section III. The Illinois Department of Corrections will be in charge of monitoring all  
7 correctional facilities to make sure they have rehabilitation programs and make sure that  
8 each public prison facility submits an evaluation form of their progress of prisoner  
9 rehabilitation every six months.

10 Section IV. This bill will request funding from the Federal Bureau of Prisons to implement  
11 the hiring of professional drug and rehabilitation counselors and rehabilitation activities.

12 Section V. This bill will go into effect June 30, 2021 upon signature of the Youth Governor  
13 of Illinois.
