

22 in the event of a flash flood or torrential downfall as to avoid any potential harm
23 caused by drownings, (k) not be near areas that are inherently dangerous, such as
24 sharp turns by cliff-edges.

25 Section II. If any funds are misallocated, the individuals responsible shall be fined
26 and fired from their role. If any inappropriate actions are taken (such as zoning
27 issues or wildlife disruptions), fines will be issued to the guilty party.

28 Section III. The IPP and the Prairie Trail Authority will collaborate in order to enforce
29 this bill. The Prairie Trail Authority will ensure that the prairie paths are built
30 correctly, and the IPP will handle the funds for the creation and maintenance of
31 these paths.

32 The governing bodies that will ensure the proper enforcement of policies will be
33 related to, (i) The Environmental Protection Agency that will ensure there is no harm
34 being done to the wild life, trees, and other aspects relating to the local
35 environment, (ii) The authorities for Prairie Path Trail in the local municipalities will
36 be responsible to make sure the integrity of the path is not breached, (iii) The United
37 States Forest Service will make sure that the rectitude of the forests and habits
38 related. And will be allowed to work with the agency mentioned in part [i], (iv) The
39 United States Natural Resources Conservation Service will determine if there are any
40 species, habitats, landscapes, or any other considerable natural resource that the
41 U.S.D.A. deems worthy of protection, (v) The United States Geological Survey will
42 confirm the the security and safety of the environment, (vi) The United States Fish
43 and Wildlife Service will make sure the fish, aquatic creatures, and animals
44 dependent on the environment related to the sanctity of the pools or other clusters
45 of water - if any of these commissions are not able to reach the requirements asked
46 of them, other agencies will be able to perform their duties.

47 Section IV. This bill will be funded through donations to the IPP. There will be no
48 taxes or reallocation of funds for this bill. Counties across Illinois will promote and
49 encourage people to donate to the IPP, and the resulting donations will go toward
50 the creation

51 Section V. This Bill shall go into effect on October 23, 2021 upon the signature of
52 the Youth Governor of the State of Illinois.
