A BILL

For an Act amending Chapter 50 Section 705-7g of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, relating to In-service Police Officer Training Requirements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.

1 Section I. This bill requires an existing in-service police training to occur every two years
2 rather than every three years. The training covers proper use of authority, procedural
3 justice, civil rights, human rights, mental health awareness, and cultural competency.

4 Section II. If a police officer does not complete this training, his/her police certification will
5 be suspended until the training is completed.

7 Section III. All actions will be overseen by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards
8 Board.

9 Section IV. The training will be funded by a reallocation of money to the Traffic and
10 Criminal Conviction Surcharge Fund, which consists of fees that felons are required to pay.
11 \$5 from each felony charge given to the County's General Fund will be reallocated to the
12 Traffic and Criminal Conviction Surcharge Fund and deposited to the Illinois Law
13 Enforcement Training Standards Board.

14 Section V. This bill will go into effect January 1, 2022 upon signature of the Youth
15 Governor of Illinois.
