A BILL

For an Act creating Chapter 410 Section 431 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, relating to Women's Health Clinic Services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.

1 Section I. This bill will create a state grant program (Illinois Regulation of Women's Health
2 Clinic Services, (IRWHCC)) to incentivize non-profit women's health clinics with categorical
3 grants in order to encourage them to provide more services. It will provide increased
4 availability of the following services: STD Testing, HIV/AIDS, abortion services, cancer
5 screening and prevention, hormone therapy, responsible contraception and birth control.
6 Project grants will be supplied to selected clinics through an application process. If clinics
7 already provide this list of services, they are eligible to put the grant towards another clinic
8 service not previously listed.

9 Section II. Categorical grants for the amount of \$10,000 will be given to organizations who
10 apply and are selected to participate in the program. This will be given for the purpose of
11 expanding the services offered at each clinic.

12 Section III. The Illinois Department of Public Health will be responsible for overseeing and
13 enacting this program and giving grants directly to requesting organizations. As stated in
14 section II, organizations will receive a \$10,000 grant as an incentive for expanding their
15 clinic services.

16 Section IV. This bill will reallocate funding from the sports betting handle to the Illinois
17 Regulation of Women's Health Clinic Services for the amount of \$1M annually.

18 Section V. This bill will go into effect 44641 upon signature of the Youth Governor of
19 Illinois.
